Executive Summary:

This course was planned as a part of a three day instructor course with a plan to increase the instructor pool, mainly for regions outside Kathmandu. As there were more than 10 potential instructors who had already done the PTC course before, we included senior faculties who would go onto be instructors and junior residents who would only do the two day course.

This course was attended by several senior faculties who were in the position of Professors and Associate Professors in their institutions. The senior faculties learning with junior residents is not a common phenomenon in Nepal. Hence breaking this taboo is an achievement in itself . Although initially there was some hesitation from the senior doctors to perform during scenario in front of their juniors, this was not seen later.

The course went smoothly . All the participants were keen learner. Even the senior faculties admitted that they learned many new things and it will change the way they will handle trauma victims in the future. They emphasized that this will help them teach other doctors the correct way of treating trauma victims.
