

PTC REPORT

The local PTC faculty at Cecilia Makiwane Hospital (Resource Centre), Mdantsane, provided the course on 12th and 13th September 2019. The funding was provided by the Eastern Cape provincial department of health through the HPTD. The course manuals were printed through the same funding. The participants from three districts (from as far as 400km away from the hospital) attended; there were 26 participants including professional nurses and emergency services personnel and clinical associates.

We also included final year medical students as observers in the course, trauma management is an essential part of undergraduate teaching curriculum. Prior to starting the course Dr Xasa – Yose the Senior Manager clinical services addressed the participants.

The course started with the pre-course test and the lectures were delivered by a panel of experienced instructors. Lunch and tea breaks were provided to the participants of course.

We started the course at 8am next day so that we could finish the course early. Mrs Green (the deputy director of HPTD) and the course director, Dr R Reddy, handed out the certificates of completion to the participants at the closing. The participants earned 12 CPD points for this activity.

Ms L Mahlangabeza and Ms A. Doyle efficiently handled all the office work for this course including arranging the venue.

A post course test was conducted and showed improvement in the analysis. In the post course instructor meeting we discussed future plans with regard to training Trauma Trained Professional Nurses in PTC. It was also decided to get the advice of the Principal of the local nursing college with regard to the scope and curricula of nurses in managing trauma patients. We felt that the course is beneficial for the clinical associates and it was decided to render more courses for them in future. It was also decided to offer a course on the 21st and 22nd of November for the clinical associates.
